Call to Order

Pledge of Allegiance

Motion by Scott with second by Feldmeier to approve the **Agenda** as presented. **Unanimously Approved**

Motion by Feldmeier with second by Scott to approve the **Minutes** of the Meeting held June 11, 2019. **Unanimously Approved**

Motion by Scott with second by Hovenkamp to approve the **List of Bills** as presented. **Unanimously Approved**

Public Comment:

County Commissioner, John Gisler reported that soil boring continues at the site of the new Kalamazoo County building.

Dawn and Tom Stapert asked if any decisions have been made in regard to compliance issues in their neighborhood since a visit from township officials. No decisions resulted from the visit.

Helen Shultz had questions about her husband's grave site. She also complained of ruts in the cemetery. Clerk Mongreig advised that she has asked another landscape company to fill the ruts.

NEW BUSINESS:

Motion by Mongreig with second by Feldmeier to accept the resignation of Schoolcraft Township Code Enforcement Officer Ryan Pedley. **Unanimously Approved**

Two dangerous structures remain in the same conditions as when the hearings were held on June 6, 2019. The owners of the structures will be notified that there will be hearings on the two structures at the August 13, 2019 regular meeting of the Schoolcraft Township Board.

Road Commission Report: Clerk Mongreig will contact the Kalamazoo County Road Commission for a status report of the 2019 Schoolcraft Township road projects.

South County Sewer & Water: The Village of Schoolcraft will hold another informational meeting at the Schoolcraft High School Performing Arts Center July 22, 2019.

South Kalamazoo County Fire Authority: Trustee Hovenkamp reported that the owner of the Pride Care facility used by the Fire Authority for meetings would like a contract with the Fire Authority to continue using the building. At the end of the contract the owner would donate the building to the South Kalamazoo County Fire Authority.

Members Time:

Clerk Mongreig reported that one tree in the Schoolcraft Cemetery is scheduled to be removed along with four trees in the Vicksburg South Cemetery.

Trustee Feldmeier asked about the progress on the Township Hall vestibule. Supervisor Ulsh reported that a contractor has not been hired. Clerk Mongreig will make calls on Wednesday, July 10, 2019.

Supervisor Ulsh suggested Schoolcraft Township create a Facebook Account. Treasurer Scott reminded him that a neighboring Supervisor believes it's a bad idea. The subject will be reviewed.
