

SCHOOLCRAFT TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING March 12, 2019

6:00 p.m. Call to Order Pledge of Allegiance

Members Present: Supervisor Ulsh, Clerk Mongreig, Treasurer Scott, Trustee Feldmeier and Ken Hovenkamp.

Motion by Feldmeier with second by Hovenkamp to approve the **Agenda** as presented. **Unanimously Approved**

Motion by Scott with second by Feldmeier to approve the Minutes of the January 8, 2019 meeting as presented. **Unanimously Approved**

Treasurer Scott reported:

Public Comment: Dawn Stapert of Kimble Lake Drive: "Same thing I have asked for the last year and 1/2, I still want to know where we stand on the issues I have with my neighbors that have not been addressed." Supervisor Ulsh directed her to Administration Manager, Christine Hamilton. Dawn Stapert asked if she would have a meeting with Chris. Karen Rodebaugh "why was it regulated over to Chris?" Supervisor Ulsh advised that as Schoolcraft Township Zoning Administrator, Christine Hamilton is the contact.

Kalamazoo County Sheriff's Lieutenant Michelle Greenlee introduced herself to the board as Schoolcraft Township's liaison.

County Commissioner, John Gisler reported that the dispatch system is up and working. The dispatch system will need funding in another 3 years.

The new county services building west of the current county building, (201 West Kalamazoo Avenue) is in discussions at a cost of \$100M.

New Business:

Motion by Mongreig with second by Hovenkamp to open the **Public Hearing for the 2019-2020 Schoolcraft Township General Appropriations Act**. Unanimously Approved

Supervisor Ulsh stated that this is the largest budget Schoolcraft Township has proposed in many years with approximately \$250,000.00 slated for road repairs and maintenance. He also stated that the board must vote on establishing Officer's wages in a Public Meeting.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that as of April 1, 2019 the salary for the **TOWNSHIP SUPERVISOR** shall be \$45,150.00.
