2011 Amendments of Michigan Zoning Enabling Act:

*2011 Public Act 97 substantially preempts local zoning authority with respect to biofuel facilities with a certain production capacity, if the facility is located on a farm.

*2011 Public Act 113 significantly preempts local zoning authority over mining land uses.
