Approve payment of bills. Motion by Hovenkamp with second by Scott to approve the list of bills for payment. **Motion carried 5-0.**

<u>Vehicle Parking and Repair Ordinance #150.</u> Following discussion over safety issues with parking in the road right-of-way, Trustee Hovenkamp made motion with second by Feldmeier that the Ordinance be tabled and members drive out and look around the lakes where most of the concern with parking occurs.

<u>South County Community Services Contract</u>. Motion by Feldmeier with second by Scott to approve the Schoolcraft Township And South County Community Services For Youth And Senior Services agreement and authorize Supervisor Ulsh and Clerk Mongreig as signers.

Schoolcraft Township Property Address Ordinance.

Following the board's review of the Property Address Ordinance with a few suggested amendments, Attorney Rolfe will return an amended Ordinance for the board to consider in December.

<u>Deferred Compensation Plan</u>. Supervisor Ulsh will meet with Dan Coleman of Edward Jones on Wednesday, November 13, 2013, to inquire if the township's current plan can be amended to include certain employees as Assessor Nathan Brousseau would like to be included.

Clerk Mongreig, (absent from the October 8, 2013 meeting), asked the board members about the raising of chickens in residentially zoned districts ruling, (dismissed at the October 8, 2013 meeting), stating that there are still residents of the township who would like the opportunity to raise chickens for egg production, and asking why Schoolcraft Township cannot follow (based on an ordinance) the city of Portage/Kalamazoo ordinance for the raising of chickens.

The members replied that Attorney Rolfe had concerns regarding the Right To Farm Act and the implications that the township may be faced with by allowing the raising of animals in residentially zoned districts.

Supervisor Ulsh presented two bids for new air conditioning. Motion by Mongreig with second by Feldmeier to award the bid to Nieboer Heating & Cooling, Inc. for a Carrier 24ABC660 16SEER Puron air conditioner and for alterations/replacement of the existing (newer) duct work, and add 2 supply runs to the farthest east side of the building at a cost of \$6,750.00. **Motion carried 5-0**

<u>Dangerous Structures Hearing October 23, 2013 – Jeff and Kelly Blodgett.</u> Jeff Blodgett agreed to appear at the Schoolcraft Township December 10, 2013 meeting to show compliance with Schoolcraft Township Building Ordinance #233 at his property located at 2259 East W Avenue. If Mr. Blodgett fails to appear December 10, 2013 Schoolcraft Township will take further action per the ordinance.

<u>Household Hazardous Waste Amendment</u> Motion by Ulsh with second by Feldmeier to sign the Amendment #2 TO The Agreement Between The County Of Kalamazoo And Schoolcraft Township with the township agreeing to provide up to \$2,500.00 to the County for services at the HHW Center. The agreement was originally entered into February 21, 2012 and amended January 15, 2013

<u>Township Park Committee Report</u>: Six trees planted in the park via a \$250.00 donation from Modern Woodman of America. The group also donated \$2,250.00 to Schoolcraft Little League (match of concessions).
