The petitions were signed by more that 50% of the owners of the property owners within the proposed district.

Ron Smith, Treasurer of the Sunset Lake Association was also present to discuss the proposed assessment district with the Township Board.

Following comments by Attorney Rolfe on the legal challenges and options of the Sunset Lake Special Assessment the Township Board's consensus was to direct Attorney Rolfe to proceed with the project according to Michigan Statute Act #188 – (as with Barton Lake Assessment) for all parcels falling in Schoolcraft Township.
