NEW BUSINESS: Site Plan Review-US 131 Sales:

Scott Peninger was present to discuss his proposed site plan for a storage building and site for boats, RV's, trailers, etc. for a permitted use on US 131. The facility and site would be used for seasonal storage and would not have regular hours or staffing. It is possible that the use could change, depending on future market demands, requiring the submission of a new site plan. Discussion centered on shared driveway investigation, lighting, and signage. As the signage has yet to be finalized, Mr. Peninger was informed that the finalized details would need to be reviewed and approved by Administrator Hamilton to secure a fully approved site plan.
