

SCHOOLCRAFT TOWNSHIP BOARD MEETING May 11, 2021 Via Zoom Video Conference

Call to Order: 6:00 p.m.

Members Present: Supervisor Ulsh, Clerk Mongreig, Treasurer Scott, Trustee Fryling, and Trustee Stafford.

Motion by Scott with second by Stafford to approve the Agenda as presented. Unanimously carried.

Motion by Stafford with second by Scott to approve the **Minutes** of the meeting the March 9, 2021 Regular Meeting. **Unanimously carried.**

Motion by Stafford with second by Scott to approve the **List of Bills** as presented. **Unanimously carried.**

Treasurer Scott reported:

Motion by Mongreig with second by Fryling to approve the **Treasurer's Report** as presented.

Citizens Time: Kalamazoo County Commissioner, John Gisler reported that the Kalamazoo County Commission is planning to replace their years old telephone system.

New Business: Application for Private Roads (verbiage and fee):

The board discussed creation of a fee schedule. It was determined that Schoolcraft Township will put in place a \$250.00 application fee and retain \$2,500.00 in escrow to cover costs incurred with the application process. The completed application/resolution will be presented at the June 2021 Regular Meeting of the Schoolcraft Township Board.

Trustee Stafford reported the **Planning Commission** approved a plan for a storage facility for inflatables on Shaver Road.

Planning Commission Member Nathan Miersma was elected Secretary of the Planning Commission.

Members Time:

Trustee Fryling reported that work has begun on the 15th Street culvert and resurfacing.

Treasurer Scott advised the board of the opening in the IT department of the township. It was decided that the township will continue with IT Right for the time being.

Clerk Mongreig shared statistics from the May 4, 2021 Special Election (KRESA Millage). 15.26% of the voters in Schoolcraft Township voted. The cost to pay Election inspectors alone was \$3,970.00

Precinct Changes: Voters in Schoolcraft Schools District (including Village residents), will vote at the Schoolcraft Township Hall, and voters in the Vicksburg Schools District (including Village residents), will vote at the Vicksburg United Methodist Church beginning in November 2021.
